JUDGING

Judging commences on Saturday 10th May 2025

Judging will be closed to exhibitors and the public.

HOW WILL YOU BE JUDGED

The Judge/s will consider the following criteria for each image:

- Technical: exposure; focus; depth of field; colour or tonal rendition; contrast; and lighting
- Visual; emotional and aesthetic appeal; process or filters
- Content; mood; emotion; relevance; subject; impact
- General characteristics; originality; style; context; photographic vision; storytelling

The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

PHOTOGRAPHY | RULES AND REGULATIONS

In conjunction with General Conditions of Entry & Competition in front of the Schedule

- All persons upon entering any class in this Schedule agree to indemnify the IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY against liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness to any Exhibit, Exhibitor or Competitor and agree that all Competitions are under the complete and total control of the IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY whose decision in all matters is final.
- Ipswich Show Society will appoint a Chief Steward to each section as its representative in all matters. Failure to comply with lawful directions from appointed Stewards, Committee or Staff or use of verbal or physical abuse will result in Disciplinary Action which may include exclusion from further Competitions and/or the Ipswich Showgrounds.
- Ipswich Show Society will appoint Judges whose decisions are final and for which no verbal or written communication will be accepted or entered into.
- Ipswich Show Society reserves the right to make any decisions, inclusions or changes to this Schedule including Conditions of Entry as it may deem fitting without further notice.
- Class definitions must be strictly adhered to.
- Prints must be commercially produced at a print lab. No prints will be accepted that appear to be printed on consumer-grade devices.
- Entries deemed to be entered in a class incorrectly will be reassigned to their correct category by the Chief Steward.
- Neither the Show Society nor the Steward, are responsible for loss or damage of entries. All reasonable care will be taken with work entered.
- Prize-winning prints and others specially nominated by the judge will be displayed. The remaining accepted prints will be shown at the discretion of the Stewards as display space permits. Every effort will be made to display all entries.
- Entries must be the bona fide original work of the Exhibitor and created on or after 17 May 2023 (24 months prior to this year's show opening day)
- All entries must not have been exhibited at any previous shows of this society.
- Permission is assumed for the Ipswich Show Society to film or photograph work for promotion or fundraising purposes.
- If prints do not meet the minimum mount size, they will not be judged as part of the competition, however, they will be displayed where possible.
- Prizes are only given if a minimum of 3 entries in class OR at the Judge's discretion

- As a family-friendly event, any full frontal nudes, violent imagery, or anything deemed inappropriate will not be hung or judged.

- AI is allowed in Class 13005 -Creative and Alternate Reality. Please read the new rules around this section.
- If a child under the age of 16 wishes to use AI or similar tools, they must enter the adult category Class 13005.
- If prints do not meet the minimum mount size, they will not be judged as part of the competition, however, they will be displayed where possible.
- All prints are to be mounted on neutral coloured backing; Black, White, or Cream only.

ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI)

Classes 13000-13004:

These categories are for 100% photographic images, only original photographs taken by the entrant are allowed. If the judge or the Ipswich Show Society wishes to confirm the image is created by the entrant, RAWs or original captures with full metadata must be provided to ISS within 24 hours of request. Failure to do so can result in disqualification.

In-camera recognition and editing programs such as Photoshop are allowed; however, images partially or wholly generated using Artificial Intelligence (Ai), the Photoshop Generative Fill tool, or similar AI-based tools are strictly prohibited.

Images incorporating stock or any other element not photographed by the entrant are not permitted.

If you have an image that uses Generative Fill or elements created by computer-generated technology, it **MUST** be entered into class 18005 Creative, Alternative Reality. The primary objective of this rule is to ensure that all entries are based on genuine photographic content to maintain the integrity of the competition.

Class 13005 – Creative / Alternative Reality:

This category has been created to allow the manipulation of photographs to create a fictional or conceptual image or digital art. Altered Reality is changing a normal photograph in a creative way to tell a story or illustrate a concept or idea.

The photographer can be creative by using any technique that enhances or changes an image with the use of (but not limited to) filters, effects, multiple images, digital mixed media, and expressing ideas or feelings in a non-traditional style.

This includes combining multiple images and elements in a final image using Photoshop or similar tools.

Manipulation can be in-camera, post-processing in Photoshop or a similar program, or a combination thereof.

The original photograph, taken by the entrant, must be the main subject, and images partially generated using computer-assisted technology such as Artificial Intelligence (Ai), the Photoshop Generative Fill tool, or similar AI-based tools are allowed in this Class only. The entrant must disclose on the entry form, whether any elements of their image have been created with the assistance of computer-assisted technology.

Images that are created electronically with no photographic origin are prohibited. All Images must have a photographic origin, and the entrant must hold the copyright for the images and not infringe any copyright, moral right, or other rights of any person. Entries must be at least 70% of the original work of the entrant, where, if questioned, the entrant can prove with RAWs or original image and Metadata, that the base image is theirs. If the judge or the Ipswich Show Society wishes to confirm the image is created by the entrant, RAWs or original captures with full metadata must be provided to ISS within 24 hours of the request. Failure to do so can result in disqualification.

AI is defined, for the purposes of this competition, as being created with (but not limited to) any text-to-image prompt engine, such as DALL-E, Stable Diffusion, MidJourney, DreamStudio, Adobe Firefly (Generative Fill).

MOUNTING AND PRESENTATION

- Minimum size 20cm x 20cm (8in x 8in) including mount/ Maximum size 50cm x 50cm (20in x 20in) including mount.
- All prints are to be mounted on neutral coloured backing; Black, White, or Cream only.
- All exhibits must have their exhibit cards securely attached to the back of their work, placed on the bottom right-hand corner.
- Display Labels will be provided upon delivery of works for the entrants to fill in the title, artist name, item number and price or NFS. The Display labels will be fixed to the bottom right-hand corner of the photograph.
- It is strongly suggested to mount images on a foam core mount board with no window as the weight of these allows an easier hanging, however, images will be accepted on any mount that meets the regulations stipulated above. **(NO THIN CARDBOARD)**
- Artwork **MUST** be mounted **BEFORE ARRIVING** to drop off your work.

SALE OF WORK

- A commission of 15% will be charged on any works sold. Please indicate your item is for sale and amount when completing the application form. Our Stewards will make up a For Sale price tag and place it on the exhibit for you.

DISPLAY OF WORK

- Please note the size of work when completing the application form. If insufficient space is available to display all the entries, the Stewards reserve the right to select which exhibits, in addition to the prize-winning exhibits, are to be displayed.
- Prints must be suitably mounted on the card with a minimum 2cm border. No framed entries will be accepted.
